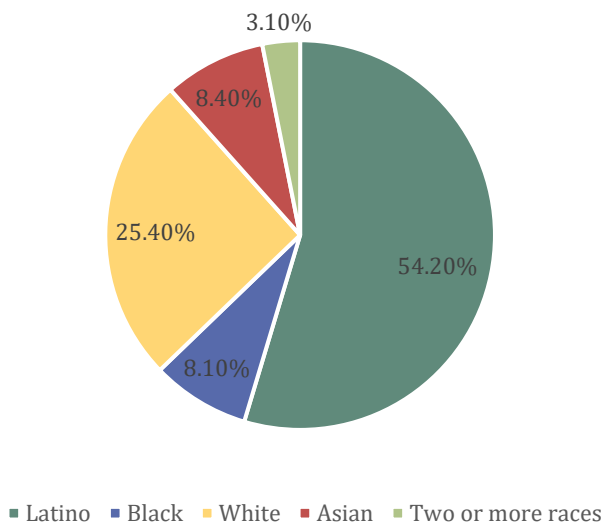

- Drug Offenses (felony): 1,188

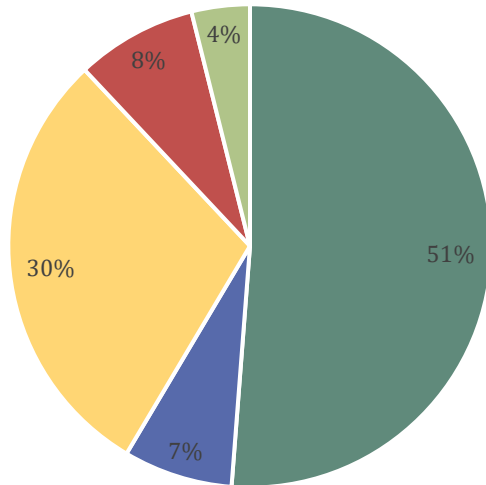

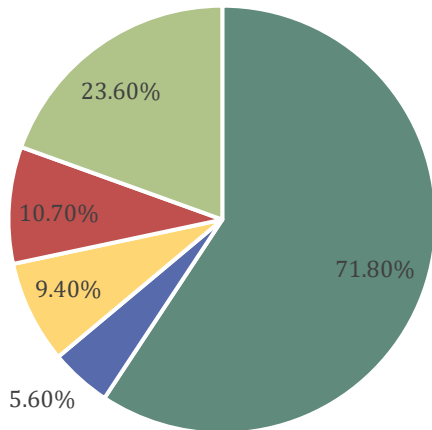
